

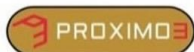

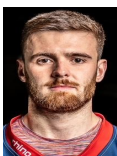

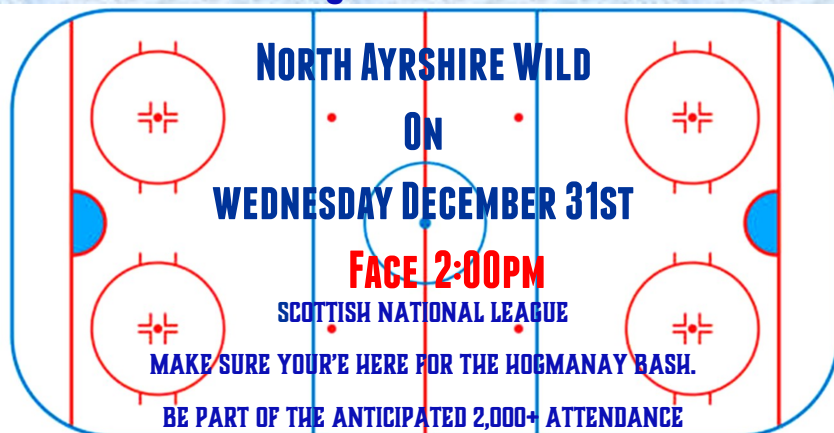

## Women's Hockey Growing In UK

Women's ice hockey in the UK is gaining in popularity and professionalism, supported by the Women's National Ice Hockey League.

WNIHL Elite is the top tier of the sport with six nationwide teams. Below WNIHL Elite sit WNIHL 1, a league encompassing national teams, and WNIHL 2 which is split into North and South regions with Under 16 leagues enabling youth development.

Growing the game is more important than ever, and the section see the merger of **Ice Hockey UK, England Ice Hockey** and **Scottish Ice Hockey** a crucial element to achieve that.

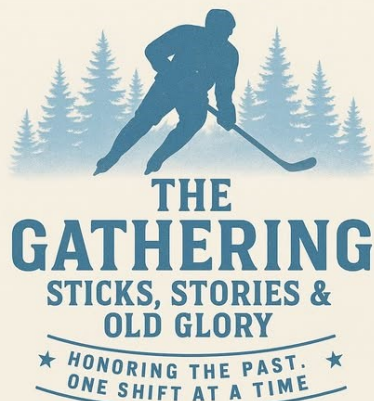

## Q - S of Hockey Terms

### Quick whistle

A stoppage in play that occasionally occurs when an on-ice official's view of the puck is obstructed while the puck is still moving or playable, but the official stops the play with a whistle. The most common example of this is a goaltender appearing to have trapped the puck underneath their catcher, yet the puck is still freely moving and within legal striking distance of the opposing players. The official will whistle the play "dead" with the puck still visible to others.

### Rebound

The situation that occurs when the puck bounces off a goalie, a player, or the net (or occasionally, the boards behind the goal line) after a shot on goal.

### Red line

The line denoting the middle of the ice surface, lengthwise.

### Referee

The official in charge of the game. Responsible for maintaining the flow of the game, calling penalties and starting and stopping play. Can be one or two referees on the ice during a game. SNL use only one.

### Referee's crease

The semi-circular area at the red line and beside the scorer's bench, into which a player may not enter when occupied by a referee during a stoppage of play

### Right wing

A winger whose faceoff position at even strength is on the center's right side. The playing surface.<sup>[3]</sup>

### Roughing

The act of contacting an opponent with the hand or fist when making a punching motion, an illegal action which incurs a penalty.

### Screened shot

A shot that the goaltender cannot see due to other players obscuring it.

### Shaft

The long part of the stick that is straight and is held by the player.

### Shift

The period of time a player' or defensive pair is on the ice before being replaced by other players.

### Shootout

A series of penalty shots by both teams to determine the winning team after a regulation game and overtime period ends in a tie.

### Shorthanded

A team is said to be shorthanded when they have fewer players on the ice than the opposing team as a result of a penalty or penalties.

### Shot on goal

A shot that will enter the goal if it is not stopped by the goaltender. Shots that either hit the side of the net or miss the goal completely do not count as shots on goal, nor do shots that hit a goalpost or crossbar and do not cross the goal line. Similarly, shots that are stopped or otherwise played by the goalie that would not, according to the judgment of the official scorer, have scored are not counted as shots on goal.

### Shots per 60 minutes

A rate stat that indicates how many shots a team or player takes or allows per 60 minutes of play.

### Shutdown pair

Two forwards or defensemen working together, fundamentally to stop the opposing team's offense players.

### Slapshot

A slapshot is a hard shot, usually with a big wind up, wherein the player bends their stick on the ice and allows the energy stored in bending the stick to launch the puck forward.

### Slashing

The act of contacting an opponent's body or stick with one's own as a result of a swinging motion. A penalty.

### Slew foot

Sweeping or kicking out a player's skate or tripping them from behind, causing them to fall backwards.

### Slot

The slot is the area on the hockey rink directly in front of the goaltender between the face-off circles on each side.

### Spearing

The act of jabbing an opponent with the blade of the stick. A double-minor penalty at minimum

### Special teams

A collective term for the players that play on the power play and shorthanded units.

### Suicide pass

A long pass to a moving teammate's feet. This causes the teammate to look down and be open to a devastating body check as the teammate receives the puck.

## The Big Four of Stanley Cup Winners.

Since the beginning of the National Hockey League (NHL), there have been countless talented players who have competed for the coveted Stanley Cup trophy. As fans, we often find ourselves wondering which hockey player has won the most Stanley Cups in NHL history.

Arguably one of the greatest hockey players in history and also known as "The Great One", Wayne Gretzky is certainly a strong contender when it comes to winning the most Stanley Cups. During his time with four different teams (Edmonton Oilers, Los Angeles Kings, St. Louis Blues and New York Rangers) over two decades, Gretzky took home four championships.

In addition to Gretzky, other noteworthy contenders include Jean Beliveau who helped lead his team – Montreal Canadiens – to ten Stanley Cup victories during his career between 1950-1971. Similarly impressive is Henri Richard who played alongside Beliveau on the same Montreal Canadiens' team from 1955-1975 while leading them to eleven championship titles.

Despite these great names from past years in NHL history though, another current-generation superstar may take home this title upon retiring: Sidney Crosby. Currently still an active player with Pittsburgh Penguins since debuting back in 2005, he already holds three titles under his belt at just age 33 despite several significant injuries over recent years requiring surgeries.

So which hockey player really has won the most Stanley Cups? You'll just have to keep watching and see whose careers will end up victorious amongst all these worthy competitors!

When it comes to winning the Stanley Cup, every hockey player dreams of hoisting that iconic trophy above their heads. Some players have had this experience multiple times and are now known as legends in the sport.

In total, only six players in NHL history have won seven or more Stanley Cups. Among them is Henri Richard, who has an impressive 11 championships under his belt. However, there is one player who stands out among even these greats: Jean Beliveau.

Born in Quebec, Canada in 1931, Jean Beliveau began his career with the Montreal Canadiens in 1950. The forward quickly proved himself to be a valuable part of the team, helping lead them to ten championships over his nineteen seasons with the organization.

Gordie Howe was another legendary player who left a significant mark on Stanley Cup history during his twenty-five-year career. While he never won quite as many championships as Beliveau or Richard, he still managed to win four throughout his time with both the Detroit Red Wings and Hartford Whalers.

New York Rangers fans will forever remember Mark Messier's dominance in game seven of the 1994 Finals against Vancouver when he scored a hat trick after guaranteeing victory beforehand. In total, Messier won six Stanley Cups throughout his storied career while playing for both Edmonton and New York City.

Last but certainly not least is Mario Lemieux. The superstar forward won two Stanley Cup championships during his time with the Pittsburgh Penguins as both a player and team owner. He may not have won as many as some of the players mentioned above, but he was still an integral part of NHL history.

No matter who you root for or how you define greatness on the ice, there's no denying that these four players are still regarded among the best to ever play in the league. Their legacy lives on through their incredible accomplishments and undeniable talent throughout their careers.
